Your health program is now working with Medicare to help pay for the medicines you need. Many American Indian and Alaska Native Elders have enrolled in Medicare drug plans. Others with Medicare are encouraged to sign up.

Your drug plan may change starting January 1. It is important to visit with your pharmacy staff if you have questions about the changes being made to your plan. If you get a letter from Medicare or the Social Security Administration about your prescription drug benefit, you should visit your clinic or benefits coordinator as soon as possible.

Please visit your clinic or benefits coordinator between November 15 and December 31.

If you are new to Medicare, you can enroll in a Medicare-approved drug plan. Extra Help with paying for the drug plan is available to you if your resources are limited.
